to open A: It sounds like you are trying to mount the ISO file to a hard drive and then view the contents of the ISO file using something other than Windows Explorer. If so, you need to do the following (see here for instructions): Mount the ISO file in Windows Explorer (if you don't already have it mounted) Click the "Start" button Click "Computer" Double click the ISO file and it should open in Windows Explorer The reason you would want to mount the ISO file is that it will act like a CD-ROM drive that the operating system can access. If you are using a Mac, you will need to use the Disk Utility to mount the ISO file.
